MINUTES OF TRANSPORT PROVIDERS & PARENTS MEETING HELD AT NEW KIDS CARE NURSERY ON WEDNESDAY 22.02.2017 From 18:00 to 19:00 hrs

AGENDA

- 1:00 Dropping and picking up of children (Breakfast& Sleeping time)
 - Leaving of children outside the gate
 - Sending young school children to pick up the little one
- 2:00 Notification of change of driver or person picking up children. (from parents or driver)
 - (Children will not be released to an unknown driver or person without parental consent, telephonically or by written consent.)
- 3:00 School holidays & Fridays
- 4:00 New security measures

The meeting was started opened at 18:15 with a prayer

1:00 The director started off by introducing the staff of NKC (New Kids Care)

She went on to point out that some drivers had the tendency of leaving the children outside the gate, some leave the children as far as across the road, a practice that is not only dangerous but a practice that is unacceptable. The parents too agreed that transport providers (drivers) will no longer be allowed to drop children outside the gate but should always come inside the school. The security team will be there to assist in parking.



The director further went on to talk about how some children were dropped off late for school making them miss their breakfast.

She then advised parents & drivers to at least bring the children to school at or by 8:15 as the first meal is served from 8:00-8:30 and in order for the children to have their breakfast with their peers. As a precaution drivers will now be asked to sign in morning drop off register.

Pick up time was also proving to be a challenge as transport providers come to school at a time when the children were either asleep or just waking up. Transport providers were then asked to come not before 12:30 as this is the time when the children were asleep.

The best time advised for pick up was 2:30 and beyond.

Drivers had developed a habit of sending other school children to pick up the little ones and this will no longer be a practice accepted by the school. The driver /transport provider has to come in and pick up the child/children.

- 2:00 The school will not release a child or children to anyone that has not been registered to do so. Should there be any change in the person picking up the child, parents are asked to notify the school on time failure to which the child will not be released.
- 3:00 During school holidays and Fridays especially children are picked up early
- 4:00 For security reasons, our gates will now be closed from 08:30am to 2:00pm any one that comes in between these times will have to fill in a register.
